## Educational Psychologist II

### Major Duties:

- ◆ Provide expert guidance and recommendations to teachers, parents, and school staff on addressing learning difficulties, behavioral issues, and social/emotional concerns
- ◆ Develop and implement individualized education plans (IEPs) and interventions to support students' unique needs
- ◆ Collaborate with teachers, administrators, and support staff to create inclusive learning environments
- ◆ Conduct workshops and training sessions for teachers and parents on relevant topics such as talent development, social-emotional support for students, and mental health awareness
- ◆ Stay up to date with current research and best practices in educational psychology and contribute to the development of school-wide policies and practices

### Requirements:

- ◆ A first degree in Psychology from a local university or equivalent
- ◆ A Master's or Doctoral degree in Educational Psychology (Professional Practice) from a local university or equivalent
- ◆ Obtained full membership of the Division of Educational Psychology of the Hong Kong Psychological Society or an equivalent status in an internationally recognised professional organization of Educational Psychology
- ◆ Relevant experience in conducting psychoeducational assessments and providing evidence-based interventions

- ◆ Knowledge of educational regulations, and policies related to special education and student support services
- ◆ Strong interpersonal and communication skills, with the ability to work effectively with students, parents, and a multidisciplinary team
- ◆ Work experience in a school setting is highly desirable
- ◆ Qualification or training or demonstrable involvement in Gifted Education will be an advantage
- ◆ Excellent communication skills (oral and written) in Chinese and English; ability to speak Putonghua will be preferred
