4. Other Learning Experiences

Other Learning Experiences (during school hours)

This aims to extend students' exposure to multiple intelligences. Courses are offered in five domains, namely Linguistic Intelligence, Logical – Mathematical Intelligence, Kinesthetic Intelligence, Aesthetics Intelligence and Others (such as leadership, service learning and religious activities). Students can choose courses from different domains every school year. School teams are also formed to provide students with special training.

After-School OLE

These activities will be arranged during weekdays and Saturdays. There is a wide variety of school teams and uniform groups, such as Soccer, Baseball, Fencing, Chinese Dance, Debate, Scout, Drama and Musical. Apart from school team training, paid courses leading to accreditation are also included, such as Rope Skipping, Swimming, Mathematical Olympiad, Instrument Classes, Ball Sports Paid courses. If students have outstanding performance, they will have the opportunity to be invited to join the school teams.

5. Scholarship / Financial Assistance

Needy students, including those from families receiving Comprehensive Social Security Assistance and those receiving financial assistance provided by the Student Finance Office, could apply and be eligible for school fee remission. Besides, we welcome students who have noteworthy performance in sports, music, performing arts, visual arts, services, leadership or academic excellence to apply for our scholarship.
