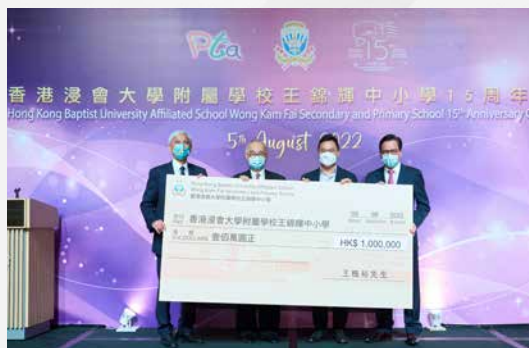

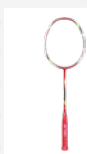

15TH ATHLETIC MEET 2022-2023



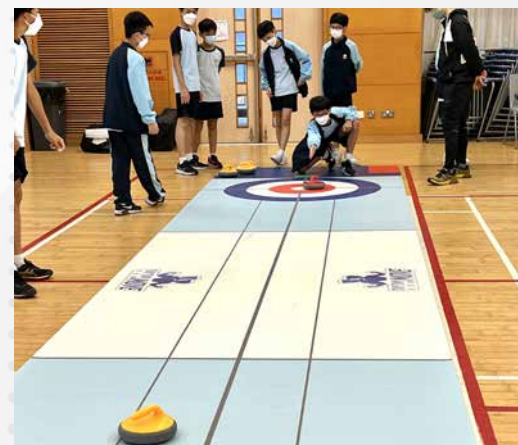

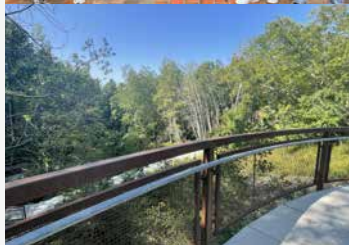


LO Hang Yui

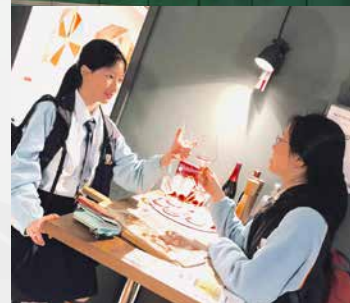
LEUNG Yau Yee

中學部 本校中小學部的天台樓層均設有空中花園。中學部七樓的空中花園是本校其中一個重要的學習園地，適合不同學科，例如綜合科學科、生物科、地理科等，將教授學生的知識應用其中。空中花園主要劃分為溫室及戶外花園空間，為校園帶來別緻的綠化景觀。以玻璃為主要物料的溫室裝設太陽能板，其產電可用於支援溫室使用；花園內除了栽種中藥、香草和實驗常用植物外，還設有多項與時並進的設施，例如水耕模型、魚池、魚菜共生系統、沼澤生態展示缸、廚餘機和其他太陽能發電裝置等，給學與教活動提供不同學習資源。花園另外又設有自動澆水裝置及太陽能驅動的過濾系統，減省人力資源之餘，又能實踐運用再生能源，配合綠色校園發展策略。

空中花園 Skyline Gardens

小學部的空中花園位於六樓天台，除了栽種外，最近更增添濃濃草藥氣息。本校與中醫藥發展基金會合作，邀請了該會的中醫師和中藥師與老師和德育及公民大使一起在空中花園建立了「百草園」。「百草園」包含了超過十個不同品種的中藥植物，都是與日常生活息息相關的品種，例如金銀花、桑樹、狼尾草和雞蛋花等。這些看似很平凡的植物卻蘊藏了許多珍貴的藥用價值，例如清熱解毒、祛痰止咳和行氣活血等功效。「百草園」會開放給所有學生參觀，負責參與種植的德育及公民大使也會向同學介紹各種中藥的特點和功用。
