Students enjoyed a variety of activities such as Chinese poem and cultural lessons, and performances. 93% of participants agreed that they had learned more about the school culture in China through class immersions and school activities.</li> <li>• No inward exchange was held due to the pandemic.</li> </ul>

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### Part B: Suggestion

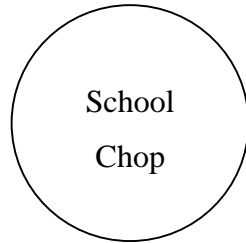
- The pandemic is over, and physical exchanges (both inbound and outbound) with our sister school can be resumed next year, allowing students to personally experience the local culture and customs of our sister school.
- To enhance the connection and communication between teachers from both schools, professional development can be strengthened, such as classroom demonstrations, classroom observations and evaluations, sharing of educational philosophies, and so on.
- Variety shows and cultural exchange activities are worth continuing. Having accumulated experience in organizing the variety show with our two sister schools this year, we could explore the possibility of expanding our connection to other sister schools.
- Keeping the WeChat public account to post A-School information, such as our campus news and updates, is an effective platform for our sister schools to keep updated and connected.
